1. INTENT

The intention is to purchase services for construction of the District 202 Phase 1 Art & Innovation Renovations work.

2. AWARD

3. TIME OF COMPLETION

Time is of the essence. Bidders should refer to and consider the Preliminary Project Schedule when preparing their bids.

4. BIDDER QUALIFICATIONS AND EVALUATION CRITERIA

All bidders must be qualified contractors and demonstrate the capability to provide services required in accordance with the bid specifications. Bids shall be evaluated as follows (not listed in order of priority):

- Bid pricing
- Compliance with specifications
- References (Complete the Reference Sheet included herein.)
- Experience
- Submittal compliance

5. SECURITY GUARANTEE

Each bidder shall submit a Bid Bond in the amount of 10% to serve as a guarantee that the Contractor shall enter into a contract with Bulley & Andrews to perform the work identified herein, at the price bid. This security shall be retained by Bulley & Andrews throughout the contract term to guarantee the Contractor's performance in accordance with the terms and conditions of the contract.

Any bid not complying with the Security requirement may be rejected as non-responsive.

6. CONTRACT BOND

A payment and performance bond are **NOT** required for this project. As construction manager/contractor will be carrying subcontractor default insurance and P&P Bond.

7. ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

ANY and ALL changes to these specifications are valid only if they are included by written Addendum to All Bidders. No interpretation of the meaning of the plans, specifications or other contract documents will be made orally. Failure of any bidder to receive any such addendum or interpretation shall not relieve the bidder from obligation under this bid as submitted. All addenda so issued shall become part of the bid documents. Failure to request an interpretation constitutes a waiver to later claim that ambiguities or misunderstandings caused a bidder to improperly submit a bid.

8. **DEFINITIONS**

- 8.1 **Base Bid** is the sum stated in the Bid for which the Bidder offers to perform the Work described in the Bidding Documents as the base, to which Work may be added or from which Work may be deleted for sums stated in Alternate Bids or Unit Prices.
- 8.2 **Alternate Bid** is an amount stated in the Bid to be added to or deducted from the amount of the Base Bid if the corresponding change in the Work, as described in the Bidding Documents, if accepted.
- 8.3 **Unit Price** is an amount stated in the bid as a price per unit of measurement for materials, equipment or services, including all overhead and profit for a portion of the Work as described in the Bidding Documents. Bulley & Andrews may reject or negotiate any unit price considered excessive or unreasonable.
- 8.4 **Owner** is the person or entity identified as such in the Agreement and is referred to throughout the Contract Documents as if singular in number. The Owner shall designate in writing a representative who shall have express authority to bind the Owner with respect to all matters requiring the Owner's approval or authorization.
- 8.5 **Architect** is procured by the Owner who is lawfully licensed to practice architecture or an entity lawfully practicing architecture in the jurisdiction where the Project is located. That person or entity is identified as the Architect in the Agreement and is referred to throughout the Contract Documents as if singular in number.
- 8.6 Construction Manager/Contractor is the person of entity identified as such in the Agreement and is referred to throughout the Contract Documents as if singular in number. The Construction Manager/Contractor shall be lawfully licensed, if required in jurisdiction where the Project is located. The Construction Manager/Contractor shall designate in writing a representative who shall have express authority to bind the Construction Manager/Contractor with respect to all matters the Contract. The term "Construction Manager/Contractor" means the Construction Manager/Contractor's authorized representative.
- 8.7 **Subcontractor** a person or entity who has a direct contract with the Construction Manager to perform a portion of the Work at the site. The term "subcontractor" is referred throughout the Contract Documents as if singular in number and means a Subcontractor or authorized representative of the Subcontractor. The term "Subcontractor" does not include a separate contractor or subcontractors of a separate contractor.

9. **RESPONSIVE BID**

- 9.1 A "Responsive Bid" is defined as a "bid which conforms in all material respects to the requirements set forth in the invitation for bids." Bidders are hereby notified that any exceptions to the requirements of this bid may be cause for rejection of the bid.
- 9.2 Bidders shall promptly notify Bulley & Andrews of any ambiguity, inconsistency or error which they may discover upon examination of the bidding documents. Interpretations, corrections and changes will be made by addendum. Each bidder shall ascertain prior to submitting a bid that all addenda have been received and acknowledged in the bid.

10. **AWARD**

Shall be made to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder who meets the specifications including financial capacity to perform, experience and qualifications performing similar work, scheduling and availability to perform the work within the time allowed.

11. INSURANCE

The Contractor shall maintain for the duration of the contract insurance, which meets the Project Specification and Contract requirements.

12. HOLD HARMLESS

The Contractor agrees to indemnify, save harmless and defend Bulley & Andrews, Evanston Township High School District 202, the City of Evanston, Perkins&Will and its consultants its agents, servants, employees, and each of them against and hold it and them harmless from any and all lawsuits, claims, demands, liabilities, losses, and expenses; including court costs and attorney's fees for or on account of any injury to any person, or any death at any time resulting from such injury, or any damage to property, which may arise or which may be alleged to have arisen out of, or in connection with the work covered by this project. The foregoing indemnity shall apply except if such injury is caused directly by the willful and wanton conduct of Bulley & Andrews, Evanston Township High School District 202, the City of Evanston, it agents, servants, or employees or any other person indemnified hereafter.

13. CHANGE IN STATUS

The Contractor shall notify Bulley & Andrews immediately of any change in its status resulting from any of the following: (a) vendor is acquired by another party; (b) vendor becomes insolvent; (c) vendor, voluntary or by operation law, becomes subject to the provisions of any chapter of the Bankruptcy Act; (d) vendor ceases to conduct its operations in normal course of business. Bulley & Andrews shall have the option to terminate its contract with the vendor immediately on written notice based on any such change in status.

14. CHANGE ORDERS

In the event that a Change Order is required, the Contractor shall review the scope of work to be performed under the contract to suggest alternatives that can be implemented to offset the cost increase of any necessary changes without sacrificing the quality and/or scope of the contract specifications.

15.PRECEDENCE

In the event of inconsistencies within or between parts of the Contract Documents, or between the Contract Documents and applicable standards, codes, and ordinances, the Contractor shall provide the better quality or greater quantity of Work or comply with the more stringent requirements; either or both in accordance with the Architect's and Bulley & Andrew's interpretation.
